Plan to Address Learning Loss

Arts & Technology Academy of Pontiac (ATAP)

Programming:

Arts & Technology Academy of Pontiac (ATAP) plans to use the 98c Learning Loss Grant to address learning loss by assessing the academic needs of all students within the District. ATAP will be utilizing an MTSS approach to gauge the severity of learning loss. Students will be tiered to determine the highest need of support. The NWEA assessment will be conducted the second week of September 2022, the Academic Coaches, the Department Heads, and the Superintendent will analyze all NWEA data to determine the tier students will be placed.

Students identified for Tier 3 Intervention, will receive small group, targeted intervention in Reading and Math during workshop times after school for one hour. Students will have access to Exact Path, and other programming to address gaps in learning based on the data from NWEA.

Students identified for Tier 2 Intervention, will receive small group, targeted intervention in Reading and Math during workshop times during school hours. Students will have access to Exact Path, and other programming to address gaps in learning based on data from NWEA.

Students identified for Tier 1 Intervention, will be determined for all students based on whole group instruction.
